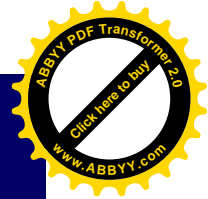
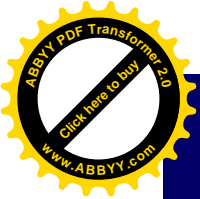

## Why this conference?

For many years there has been a noticeable lack of highly qualified personnel in the Republic of Srpska and Bosnia and Herzegovina in the field of tourism, which would have been able to develop tourism on a new basis in the way it is now developing in the world. Modern information technology, global trend of increasing number of tourists, new airport lines with much more favorable conditions of travel, new forms of tourism, previously poorly developed (e.g. rural, eco, adventure, conference, spa, sports, etc..) are just some of the determinants of today's tourism world. Numerous studies have shown that the Republic of Srpska and Bosnia and Herzegovina have a solid foundation for tourism development taking into account natural conditions. But in all these studies it is almost always referred to a lack of staff with minimal competence to deal with today's tourism, which in addition to professional competence in the field of tourism implies a number of generic competencies that include the active knowledge of foreign languages , ICT technology, teamwork, etc..



It is planned for this conference to become traditional and organized each year at Jahorina in the last week of March.



On the first day, works by invitation of the respectable names from the Western Balkans would be presented and the discussion led by eminent scientific names in this field would take place.

On the second day, young scientific workers and students, PhD students, postgraduates would be offered the chance to present their work with themes of importance to the development of tourism industry.

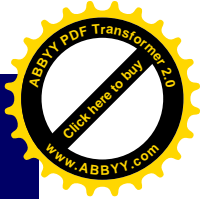
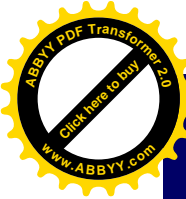
On the third day, it is planned to organize an open championships in skiing of Bosnia and Herzegovina university teaching staff and participants of the conference.

## Why this conference at the Jahorina?

Jahorina (Serbian/Bosnian: Jahorina, Serbian Cyrillic: Јахорина pronounced [jâxorina]), is a mountain in south-eastern Bosnia and Herzegovina, located in Pale, Republika Srpska. It borders fellow Olympic mountain Trebević. Jahorina is 1913 meters (6276 feet) tall, making it the second tallest of Sarajevo's mountains, behind Bjelašnica.

Like other three mountains, Igman, Bjelašnica and Trebević, Jahorina is a popular destination for a variety of outdoor sports and activities. During the 1984 Winter Olympics, Jahorina was the site of the women's alpine skiing events. Today, Jahorina remains a popular destination for skiing, hiking, and sledding, with over 40 km of ski trails and modern facilities.

Accommodation at the hotel is on half board basis (bed, breakfast, dinner).

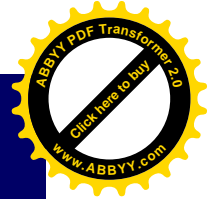
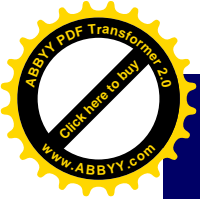
